Chris Wyatt is a payments and software executive who turns regulated, high-friction payment flows into scalable, automated businesses.

As General Manager at Change Healthcare, the largest US healthcare clearinghouse, he led a 350-person organization and a \$400M P&L across B2B and Patient Payments. He rebuilt a legacy print-and-mail remittance business into an \$8B virtual card operation and drove \$80M of net-new revenue in 18 months on \$160B in annual payment volume.

He co-founded Finexio, a B2B payments network, and scaled it from pre-revenue to \$20M in ARR and \$12B+ in annual payment volume on a multi-bank orchestration platform, backed by \$75M raised from JPMorgan and other institutional investors. He serves as Chief Operating Officer and a Board Member, and set the company's product, partnership, and go-to-market strategy.

Earlier, Chris was an operator at American Imaging Management through WellPoint's \$300M acquisition in 2007, and held network optimization and pricing roles at UnitedHealth Group. Across two decades he has carried more than \$700B in cumulative payment volume.

He is the author of three books on the future of payments and agentic finance (2024 to 2026) and contributes to Federal Reserve, NACHA, and HIMSS working groups. He holds a Master of Health Services Administration (MHSA) from the University of Michigan.

Chris is opening an executive search for President, COO, or General Manager roles, and for CEO of a company where domain expertise, building from zero, and commercial outcomes decide the seat. Healthcare payments, B2B fintech, and payments infrastructure are home.
